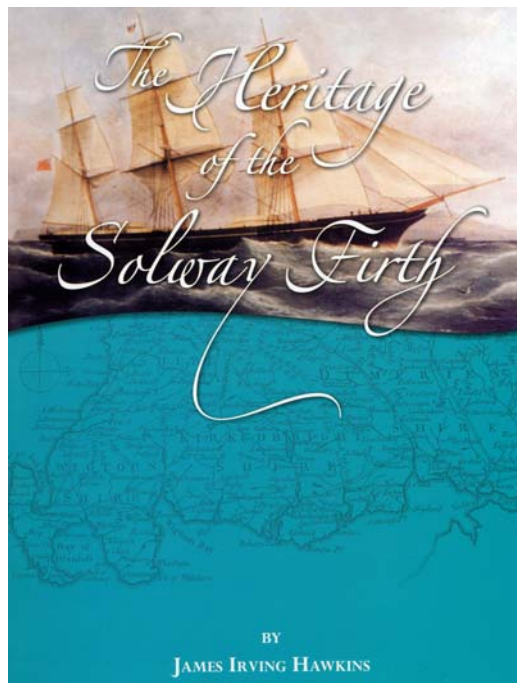
An illustrated account of Solway Firth fishing and coastal traffic.
