Annan Town Hall.
When the Town Hall was built in 1878 Annan Town Council did not have sufficient money for a clock. This was gifted to the town as the Chalmers bequest and installed in 1901. Similarly when the building was completed the plinth above the balcony where the flagstaff is secured was intended to accommodate the statue of Robert the Bruce or a future famous person but this space has never been filled.
