WALK 101

SUNDAY 13 JANUARY 2008

ESKDALEMUIR

Distance	8 miles / 13 km.
Walk Time	4.0 hours approx.
Walk Description	From Eskdalemuir Church across White Esk river and on to Raeburnhead by way of the old Roman Road. Forest track to Grey Hill and returning to Eskdalemuir. Apart of the walk covers rough ground with no path. One small fence to be climbed over. Maximum altitude 368 metres (1200 ft.). Accumulated climbing approx. 200 metres (650 ft.).
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. From Annan to Lockerbie then B723 to Eskdalemuir.
Walk Starting Point	10.30 a.m. Eskdalemuir Church. Car parking by the graveyard. No toilets at start.
Walkers Dogs	Sorry no dogs – farm livestock in fields.
Refreshments	Bring picnic lunch, snacks and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots and warm and waterproof clothing.
