### **AROUND ARMATHWAITE & AINSTABLE**

**[A Cup-Final walk for everyone. Fans who couldn't get a ticket and can't bear to watch or listen; fans of other clubs and those few, those very few who don't like football! ]**

Distance	6 miles / 10 km.
Walk Time	3.5 hours approx.
Walk Description	Moderate. Initially along the banks of the river Eden with a slight incline through Coombe Woods, along farm tracks, country lanes and across open fields.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. From Annan take the A75 to M6 (South). Leave M6 at junction 42 then at Golden Fleece roundabout take the second exit on the A6 signposted Penrith. Carry on along the A6 and just past High Hesket turn left at the signpost for Armathwaite and Ainstable. Continue along this road until you reach a T junction then turn right, under the railway viaduct to Armathwaite village, and the village hall is on the left hand side. Park at the rear of the village hall.
Walk Starting Point	10.30 a.m. at Armathwaite village hall. Toilets available.
Walkers Dogs	Sorry no dogs.
Refreshments	Bring snacks and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots, waterproof jacket and trousers.
