BardOn Mill

Distance	7 miles approx.
Walk time	5 hours approx.
Walk Description	Moderate walk with initial steep ascent of the heather, fern and rock-clad Thorngraston Common with magnificent views over the South Tyne valley and Hadrian wall countryside, then down to the Roman fort at Vindolanda and along the secluded valley of Chainley Bum. We carry on to the village of Beltingham with its ancient trees and burial plot with Royal family connections and back to Bardon Mill.
Travel	Murray St. car park at 9.30am. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. Annan to Brampton, from Brampton take A69 east towards Hexham. Turn off right at sign for Bardon Mill (Approx. 4 miles past Haltwhistle). At Bardon Mill turn left at shop (opposite pottery chimney) to railway station car park.
Walk start	10. 30am. At Station car park. Sorry no toilets.

Refreshments	Bring snacks and drinks
