### **Gilsland Circular**

Distance	6.0 miles /10.0 km.
Walk Time	4.0 hours approx.
Walk Description	Generally a flat walk along a riverside path,through farm yards and across fields to Thirlwall castle (ruins) Then we return to Gilsland via the Hadrian's Wall path. One ascent along a tarmac road. Some stiles.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30a.m. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. From Brampton take the A69 towards Hexham.About 6 mls. from Brampton turn off left at road signposted Denton/Gilsland/Spadeadam.F ollow this road for 2 miles into Gilsland.Immediately on entering Gilsland,park in the car park on the right hand side next to the school
Walk Start	10.30 a.m. In the above carpark. Sorry no toilets available
Walkers Dogs	<b>Sorry No Dogs as livestock in fields.</b>
Refreshments	Bring snacks and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots, waterproof jacket and trousers.
