Laurieston Forest

Distance	6.5 miles / 10.5 km.
Walk Time	4.0 hours approx.
Walk Description	<p>A forest walk starting from the village hall in Laurieston near Castle Douglas. Following paths through Retreat Wood & Kenick Wood. The route gives views to the South & East. Scree Hill, Criffel & the Lake District hills can all be seen. (on a good day!!!).</p> <p>Walk covers road, farm & forestry tracks which may have some muddy sections if weather has been wet.</p>
Travel	<p>Murray Street car park at 9.30a.m. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. From Annan take the A75 to Castle Douglas. Shortly before the Castle Douglas bypass turn right onto the B795 (signposted Laurieston) continue on this road till you come to the crossroads in the centre of Laurieston village. Go straight across the junction, parking is on rough ground at the side of the village hall which is situated on the Left about 40 metres down this road.</p>
Walk Start	<p>10.45 a.m. from Laurieston Village Hall. (Toilets available in village hall) Map: OS Explorer No.320 Grid Ref: NX 681648</p>
Walkers Dogs	No dogs allowed.
Refreshments	Bring usual snacks and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots, waterproof jacket and trousers.

Everyone is welcome. You can turn up on the day but advance notice is always helpful.
