SUNDAY 10th OCTOBER 2010

CRAIGIEBURN FOREST

Distance	6.8 miles / 11.0kms
Walk Time	Approx. 5 hours.
Walk Description	A steady climb of about 800ft for the first 3.8 miles to the top of the walk then downhill to the end. We will have to cross a couple of burns and boggy bits which might test your footwear and there is a diversion of about half a mile across some felled ground which will require care. We should have fine views of Moffatdale, Annandale and beyond.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30am. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. A708 from Moffat towards Selkirk. Craigieburn car park is on the left about one and a half miles past the traffic lights controlling the narrow section at Craigieburn Nursery.
Walk Starting Point	10.30 a.m. from Craigieburn Forest car park. There are no toilets.
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Waterproofs (normally essential on any walk we co-ordinate), walking boots, poles, warm gear.
