Barnkirk Point

As this is Remembrance Sunday our walk starts later than usual. The route is short to enable the walk to be completed before darkening. The route follows the River Annan from Annan High Street to Barnkirk Point, where the River Annan meets the Solway Firth, and then returns to Annan.
