

ANNAN WALKING GROUP
WALK 183
SATURDAY 23rd July 2011
MOSSDALE

Distance	7 miles / 11.2kms
Walk Time	Approx. 5 hours.
Walk Description	The first 3 kilometres are along the old "paddy" line crossing the Black Water of Dee and Loch Stroan by the Stroan Viaduct. We then have a gentle climb over Stroan Bridge and moor track for about 2 kilometres before descending to follow a quiet lane for another 2 kilometres. We have to follow the A 7 62 for 400 metres but there is a safe verge. The last three kilometres takes us over fields and through woods by the Black Water of Dee and back to Mossdale. The views are beautiful and it should not be too taxing a walk.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30am. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. A75 to just before Castle Douglas where we turn left onto the B795 for Laurieston (crossing the A 713 after a couple of miles). Turn right onto the A 7 62 at Laurieston. The car park is on the right just before the shop at Mossdale.
Walk Starting Point	10.30 a.m. from Mossdale car park. There are no toilets. (the shop does however sell icecream!)
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Waterproofs (normally essential on any walk we co-ordinate), walking boots, poles, warm gear.
