A pleasant historic walk along the southern shore of the Solway from Port Carlisle (Fisher's Cross) to Bowness the western end of Hadrian's Wall and beyond.

Note!

Binoculars may be useful to help identifying features over the Solway.

Approximate Distance	6.0 Miles (9.7km)
Approximate length of walk	4.0 hours
Walk description	An easy walk on tidal saltings, minor roads and paths.
No Dogs	Livestock may be in some fields.
Travel	Murray Street Car Park Annan at 9.30am. The mini bus has been booked. The simplest route is via Burgh by Sands off the new Carlisle western by-pass
Walk starting point and time	Solway Methodist Chapel on the left just before Port Carlisle, 10.30 am approximately.
Car Parking	Beside the Solway Methodist Chapel
Toilets	At the Methodist Chapel and at Bowness Village hall
Refreshments	Bring your own food, refreshments available at pubs in Port Carlisle and Bowness and a tearoom in Bowness
