Gretna – Quintinshill and The River Sark

Starting at the Old Blacksmith's Shop at Gretna Green, the route takes in country to the North and East, passes through Springfield and Gretna, and returns via the railway station.

[You are cordially invited by the Old Blacksmith's Shop Visitor Centre to visit their shops, etc. The shops and café will be open 9 a.m. until 5 p.m.]

Distance	10km / 6 miles approx.
Walk Time	3 hours approx.
Walk Description	Mainly to the North of Gretna, the walk is on hard surfaced farm tracks, public roads and fields. Some short muddy sections, but suitable for all weather conditions. Generally level, some slight inclines, two grassy banks.
Travel	Leave Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Minibus available for 16 passengers.
Walk Starting Point	9.50 a.m. Overspill car park behind Old Blacksmith's Shop and Visitor Centre.
Walkers Dogs	OK on leads.
Refreshments	Bring drink and a snack as required.
Equipment	Warm waterproof outdoor wear. Walking boots or stout shoes.
