

ANNAN WALKING GROUP
WALK 82
SUNDAY 11 MARCH 2007
CARSETHORN-THE SOLWAY SHORE

Distance	5.5 miles / 9 kms. approx.
Walk Time	3 hours including stops and lunch.
Walk Description	A shore walk (2 miles) followed by woodland tracks and country roads. Flat with max. ascent of 82 feet (25 m.). High tide 3.50 p.m. should allow us to walk along the sandy beach which may be strewn with driftwood or alternatively to walk over more rocky ground. One short but steep downhill section, which may be slippery if wet weather but assistance will be at hand.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Please note no mini-bus available so bring car if possible. FROM ANNAN: to Dumfries then over St Michaels Bridge and A710 through New Abbey to Kirkbean then left and 2 miles to Carsethorn.
Walk Starting Point	Car park by beach at Carsethorn at 10.30 a.m. Overspill parking available in car park of Steamboat Inn. Toilets at car park.
Walkers Dogs	No dogs please.
Refreshments	Bring snacks and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots, waterproofs etc.
