

**ANNAN WALKING GROUP**  
**WALK 93**  
**SATURDAY 25 AUGUST 2007**  
**CASTLE O'ER, ESKDALEMUIR**

Distance	8 miles /13 km.
Walk Time	4.5 to 5 hours including stops.
Walk Description	Starting from King Pool the walk will pass through forest at Crossdykes Knowe and Horse Knowe. Lunch by Old Hill Fort at Tanlawhill. Return to start point by Black Esk River. Walk will be along roads, forest track and approx. one mile over rough ground with no path which may be wet. Some small hills – maximum height 285 metres (926 ft.) and an accumulated climb of 190 metres (618 ft.).
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. From ANNAN travel to Langholm then left over bridge at end of High Street onto B709 to Eskdalemuir, (approx. 10 miles from Langholm to walk start). Go straight on at Enzieholm Bridge ( <b>do not</b> cross bridge) then next right to Eskdalemuir. Cross Black Esk Bridge and car park is approx. 200 yds. on the right.
Walk Starting Point	10.30 a.m. at White Esk King Pool Car Park, where Black Esk & White Esk Rivers meet. No toilets.
Walkers Dogs	Sorry no dogs.
Refreshments	Bring picnic lunch, drinks snacks etc.
Equipment	Usual walking gear waterproofs and boots recommended.
