| Dogs not allowed | Over open hills with grazing livestock. |
| Annan meeting point | Murray Street car park Annan at 9.30am The minibus will be available for 16 passengers. |
| Travel route | From Annan take the B6357, to Canonbie and then continue on the same route to Newcastleton. About 25 miles total. |
| Walk starting point and time | Douglas Square, Newcastleton at 10.30am |
| Car parking | Car parking in Douglas Square where toilets are available. |
| Refreshments | Bring your own, but food and refreshments are available at the local hotels. |
