WALK 96
SUNDAY 14 OCTOBER 2007
BRAMPTON & THE RIVER GELT

Distance	7 miles / 11.5 km.
Walk Time	4.0 hours approx.
Walk Description	Taking field paths from Brampton to the Capon Tree Monument we follow woodland paths overlooking the River Gelt to Low Gelt Bridge. Using quiet country roads & field paths we continue on to the hamlet of Greenwell. Returning, we walk the banks of the River Gelt to Middle Gelt Bridge and on through Gelt Wood before reaching to our start point in Brampton.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30a.m. Mini bus available for 16 passengers. From Annan take the A75 to Gretna, and then take the A6071 to Brampton via Longtown. About 26 miles.
Walk Starting Point	10.30 a.m. Car park off Gelt Road Brampton. On entering Brampton take the B6413 heading for Town Centre (Front Street) after passing St Martin's Parish Church take first right into Gelt Road, car park is 50 metres up on left hand side. Toilets are available off Beck Lane in Brampton.
Walkers Dogs	Dogs on Leads (livestock in some fields).
Refreshments	Bring snacks and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots, waterproof jacket and trousers.
