

ANNAN WALKING GROUP

WALK 98

SUNDAY 11th NOVEMBER 2007

MOUNT ANNAN [afternoon walk]

This route follows the River Annan then traverses Mount Annan estate.
Red squirrel and roe deer are frequently seen in the woodland.

Approximate distance	Just over 3.0 Miles
Approximate length of walk	About 2.00 Hours, to be completed before dark.
Walk description	On woodland paths with some short gradients. Some tracks are muddy and covered by fallen leaves and care is required.
Dogs on leads please	Horses and livestock graze in adjacent fields.
Annan meeting point	Murray Street car park Annan at 1.30pm The 16 seat minibus will be available.
Travel route	From Annan take the B723 towards Lockerbie. Proceed for two miles. Brydekirk is signposted to the right on a minor road.
Walk starting point and time	Outside the Brig Inn Brydekirk at 1.45 pm.
Car parking	On street Parking near the Brig Inn, Brydekirk.
Refreshments	None essential. The Brig Inn is open all day.
Equipment	Usual walking gear.
