WALK 250

Saturday 28th June 2014

Ullswater.

Distance	6.5 miles / 10.5km.
Walk Time	4 hours plus.
Walk Description	An undulating walk starting in the picturesque village of Pooley Bridge, we go along field paths close to the shore of Ullswater as far as Waterside House. Then a gradual ascent up to Crook-a-dyke Farm & over the sometimes very muddy Sharrow Mire before starting on a short moderately steep section along the base of the crags of Barton Fell followed by a gentle rise to the ancient stone circle "The Cockpit" on Moor Divock. From there it is an easy descent back to Pooley Bridge.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.00 a.m. Minibus available. From Annan take the A75/M6 South to Penrith. Leave motorway at Junction 40 & take the A66 West. At the 1 st roundabout take 2 nd exit onto A592 (Ullswater). At junction with the B5320 turn Left for Pooley Bridge. Car Park is on the far side of the bridge crossing the River Eamont at entry into the village. Parking Fees £5 up to 4 hrs. £7 up to 12 hrs Please Note : Minibus leaving at the earlier time of 9.00 am
Walk Start	10.10 a.m. from Car Park at Pooley Bridge. Toilets available in centre of village. Note: 20p piece is required for entry to toilets
Walkers Dogs	<u>No Dogs</u> Livestock in Fields
Refreshments	Bring usual snacks, drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots and poles advisable, waterproof jacket and trousers.
