

ANNAN WALKING GROUP

Walk 263

Sunday 11th January 2015.

Clarencefield via Bower Houses through to Ruthwell, Brow Well and Ruthwell Church (Flat Circular Walk)

Distance	Approx 6.5 miles (or a shorter version could be undertaken omitting the Brow Well, Ruthwell and Ruthwell Church area. This shorter version is approx 5 miles).
Duration	Allow 4/4.5 hours
Description	Very flat walk. The walk commences on the main road and carries on through country lanes and woodland. Very muddy in places so boots and waterproofs are essential.
Travel	Minibus leaves Murray St car park at 9.30am. Parking is available at Clarencefield Village Hall on the B724 and the walk should depart from there at about 9.50am.
Toilets	Toilets available in the Village Hall. The hall keeper has requested that "no muddy boots are to enter the hall".
Dogs	Guide dogs only.
Refreshments	Usual "banana" stop and lunch stop. Make sure you have something waterproof to sit on.
Equipment	Waterproof trousers, walking stick, boots and gaiters strongly advised. (If weather very wet, may take the shorter version of the walk).
