SUNDAY 11 OCTOBER 2015
HAWESWATER

Distance	5.5 miles / 9 kms.
Walk Time	4.5 hours.
Walk Description	A linear walk on tracks following the western edge of the Haweswater Reservoir from Burnbanks at its northern end to Mardale Head at its foot. Lovely scenery. Some uphill and downhill following the contours of the fells above the reservoir.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Mini bus available. From Annan 48 miles (1 hour) journey. Route via M6 to Jct. 40 Penrith, then 2nd. exit at roundabout onto A66, then 4th exit at next roundabout onto A6, then through Eamont Bridge and right at mini roundabout, then next left after Yanwath for Askham. then 5 miles on to Burnbanks. Toilets in Penrith if necessary.
Walk Starting Point	11.00 a.m. Car park area on left at Burnbanks.
Walkers Dogs	Guide dogs only.
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks including plenty of water if a warm day.
Equipment	Walking boots and poles. Usual outdoor clothing.
