Castle Carrock & Reservoir

Distance	4 Miles Approx (With opportunity to do more or less)
Walk Time	3 Hours Approx
Walk Description	Mainly flat walk on country paths and lanes.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Mini-bus available Parking on street near Duke of Cumberland Pub Junction 44 at Carlisle, take A689 2nd road of roundabout to Brampton. At Brampton roundabout, take first left, then almost immediate first right. Continue for about a mile to cross road, and turn right to Castle Carrock. In village turn left signposted Geltsdale and park on the street.
Walk Starting Point	On Street, near the Duke of Cumberland Pub, in the village at 10.30am.
Walkers Dogs	Only Guide Dogs on minibus, but members can bring their own dogs by their own cars , if they like!
Refreshments	Usual refreshments from home, bananas etc
Equipment	Walking boots, waterproofs etc. If there has been rain boots and gaiters recommended.
