ANNAN WALKING GROUP WALK 298 SUNDAY 10 JULY 2016 ALMORNESS PENINSULA

Distance	9 kms. / 5.5 miles
Walk Time	4 hours.
Walk Description	A walk on tracks, some rough, sheeptracks and grassland, no great height but uphill and down dale to the secluded White Port bay just short of Almorness Point. One ladder stile en-route. Back along Horse Isles Bay and past Almorness House again to the car-park. If weather kind great views over Auchencairn Bay (Hestan Island) to Robin Rigg and the Cumberland coast. Also over Rough Firth to Rockcliffe on return. (If weather very unkind the walk route may be altered and restricted to the eastern side of the peninsula)
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m . Mini bus available. From Annan 35 miles (1 hour) journey via Dumfries then the A711 through Dalbeattie, past Palnackie and then a further 1 mile before turning left onto a minor single track road signposted ORCHARDTON TOWER. At the T junction just after the Tower turn right and follow this minor road to the Car-Park just before the Private Road to Almorness House. Toilets in John Street, Dalbeattie if necessary.
Walk Starting Point	10.45 a.m. Car park area on left hand side of road just before the start of the no-vehicular access road to Almorness House.
Walkers Dogs	No dogs. Game bird breeding area plus sheep and cows.
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks including plenty of water if a warm day.
Equipment	Walking boots and poles. Usual outdoor clothing.
