Distance	6¼ miles / 10 kms.
Walk Time	4 hours.
Walk Description	A flat low level walk, almost subterranean, from Rockcliffe following the Cumbria Coastal Path with a detour along the edge of the Rockcliffe Marsh Nature Reserve (with permission of Castletown Estate). Walk on paths, fields, tracks and minor roads. <b>Some stiles.</b> May be muddy in parts depending upon the weather.
Travel	Murray Street car park at <b>9.30 a.m.</b> Mini bus available. <b>From Annan</b> 15 miles to Rockcliffe via Gretna and minor roads.
Walk Starting Point	<b>10.00 a.m.</b> Car park at <b>Rockcliffe Centre</b> just past the <b>Crown &amp; Thistle Pub</b> when approaching through the village from the Gretna end.
Toilets	Toilets al-fresco.
Walkers Dogs	Guide dogs only on mini-bus. Dogs on walk okay on lead.
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots and poles. Usual outdoor clothing for the time of year.
