KINGMOOR NATURE RESERVES

Distance	7 kms. / 4.5 miles
Walk Time	2 - 2.5 hours.
Walk Description	A flat walk. Kingmoor North and Kingmoor South Nature Reserves lie on the fringe of Carlisle and are the remains of a much larger woodland which extended north from the Kingmoor Road in Carlisle to the M6 motorway north of the city. Once the site of a horse racing course, Kingmoor now offers visitors a peaceful and relaxing walk in woodlands.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Mini bus available. From Annan 18 miles via A75 to J44 then western ring road A689 to 4th roundabout for Kingmoor Road. Kingmoor Terrace is first on left.
Walk Starting Point	Parking for 20 cars on left off Kingmoor Terrace at south-western corner of reserve. 10.00 a.m. Car park in Kingmoor Terrace.
Walkers Dogs	Dogs on lead okay. Only guide dogs on mini-bus.
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots and usual outdoor clothing.
