

**ANNAN WALKING GROUP**  
**WALK 330**  
**SATURDAY 25 NOVEMBER 2017**  
**WETHERAL & GREAT CORBY**

Distance	3.5 miles / 5.6 kilometres approx.
Walk Time	2.5 to 3 hours.
Walk Description	River Eden walk on woodland and river bank paths which could be muddy. Some steep steps (could be slippery) down to St. Constantine's Caves but this part is optional. Good views of the river and Corby Castle and also from the viaduct linking the two villages.
Travel	Murray Street car park at <b>9.30 a.m.</b> Mini bus available. <b>From Annan</b> east bound to the M6. Leave at J43 and take the first exit onto A69 eastbound. After 1.4 miles turn right onto Plains Road (signed Wetheral). Continue for about 1.3 miles then turn right onto Steele's Bank into village and park at the village green.
Walk Starting Point / Toilets	<b>10.15 a.m.</b> from Village Green. No toilets
Walkers Dogs	Dogs on lead okay. Only guide dogs on mini-bus otherwise travel in owners car.
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Walking boots and usual outdoor clothing. Sticks recommended for descent to caves.
