WALK 345
SATURDAY 28 JULY 2018
NEWCASTLETON - PRIEST HILL

Distance	Approx. 5 miles / 8 kilometres.
Walk Time	4 hours approx.
Walk Description	Circular walk along grassy and woodland paths with a couple of gentle slopes. Stunning views over the Liddle Valley and Border Hills.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Mini bus available. From Annan 27 miles via B6357 to Canonbie, go through village, over bridge and continue on same route to Newcastleton. Turn right at start of village (signposted Dykecrofts), over bridge then take first left turn on corner (100yds). Keep on this road to the end (Priest Hill car park).
Walk Starting Point / Toilets	10.30 a.m. Car park Priest Hill Toilets in Newcastleton (30p). Enter village and turn left into Langholm Street (opposite Holm Stores), toilets on left hand side by Fire Station.
Walkers Dogs	Dogs on leads welcome in owners cars. Guide dogs only on bus.
Refreshments	Bring lunch and drinks (extra water if weather still hot).
Equipment	Usual outdoor.
