SATURDAY 26th OCTOBER 2019

BESSIE'S HILL and CASTLE O'ER FOREST

Distance	5.5 miles
Walk Time	Approx. 4 hours
Walk Description	A short gradual climb to start, then walking on mostly level forest roads. We visit two Iron Age Hill Forts on route with good views of the Esk Valley half of walk uphill (taking it slowly) and second half down. Walking on good grass and stone tracks.
Travel	Murray Street car park at 9.30am . Mini-bus available. Join the M74 north of Eaglesfield. Take the first exit into Lockerbie follow the main street to the old Academy. Turn right to follow the B723 through Boreland to Eskdalemuir Church. Turn right onto the B709. After 200 yards go straight ahead at the road junction signed Bailiehill. After approx. 2 miles the car park sign is on the right beside the wood.
Walk Start Point / Toilets	10.30am approx. at the car park. No Toilets.
Dogs	In owners car.
Refreshments	Bring own snacks, lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Usual outdoor wear for the time of year.
