Walk Leader(s)	Roderick McCallum 01461 202 104
Distance	Approx. 4 ½ miles / 6 kms.
Walk Time	Approx. 3 ½ hours.
Walk Description	A walk from the village along the Liddel Water and the old railway track before striking up hill by farm roads and hill tracks via Railtonside and Woolhope to Blackburn Farm A climb of some 60 metres (200 ft.). Then return through fields and by the northern edge of Pathhead Moss before taking a woodland path back to the village.
Travel	From Annan 27 miles via Canonbie. (approx. 45 mins.). Parking in Douglas Square (either side) in centre of Newcastleton village. Mini-bus available. Murray Street car park at 9.30 a.m. Covid safety measures apply.
Walk Start Point / Toilets	Start Point – Information Point on eastern side of Douglas Square at 10.30 a.m. Toilets – in Langholm Street just off S.W. corner of Douglas Square. Cost 30 pence.
Dogs	Dogs okay but will need to be on leash if stock in fields. Guide dogs only on bus.
Refreshments	Bring mid-day snacks and drinks.
Equipment	Usual outdoor gear for time of year but boots and poles recommended because of rough hill tracks and in wood where care has to be taken with tree roots.
