

ANNAN WALKING GROUP – WALK 440

SUNDAY 12th MARCH 2023 GELT WOODS & GREENWELL

Walk Leader(s)	Duncan Card (07716 798 831)
Distance	Approx. 5 miles.
Walk Time	Approx. 4 hours.
Walk Description	This is an undulating circular walk through woods, across livestock fields and along the river bank. This walk is rated as moderate with some steep slopes and slippery surfaces. The walk is on beaten earth paths with exposed roots and stones, muddy in places, on gravel paths, across fields and on short stretches of tarmac. The walk starts with an steady incline for approx. the first mile and a half to the highest point of approx. 250ft.
Travel	The start point is approx. 25miles / 35mins. by car from Annan. Take the A75 towards Carlisle and continue onto the M6. At Junction 43 take the slip road off. At the roundabout take the first exit onto the A69. After approx. 6 miles turn right signposted Hayton Town Head. After approx. 200 yards take left over bridge and immediately right into the car park. Mini-bus available for 16 passengers. Return Fare £4. Seats are on first come first served basis. Please bring change of shoes to keep the bus clean. Mini-bus departs Murray Street car park, Annan at 9.30 a.m.

Dogs	Dogs on short leads only, and travelling in owners car.
Refreshments	Bring snacks, lunch and drinks.
Equipment	Appropriate outdoor gear for the time of year and ground conditions. Don't forget to bring a change of shoes for travelling back in the bus.
